- To create a communication channel with diverse stakeholders that Discourse in Psychosis might impact.



Actions



- Stablish a good pattern of communication with different stakeholders (mainly people with lived experience)
- How to accommodate different expectations from different stakeholders
- Survey to meet those expectations from different stakeholders
 - Helping in designing experiments, analysis, and potential products aligned with stakeholders' expectations (considering cultural diversity)
- Disseminate the consortium and create opportunities to work with other societal sectors than academia.
